## LOCAL LAW NO. 1           COUNTY OF HAMILTON

A local law to fix the compensation of the County Clerk of the county of Hamilton.

Be it enacted by the Board of Supervisors of the county of Hamilton as follows:

SECTION 1. The annual salary of a county clerk of the county of Hamilton is hereby fixed at the sum of five thousand five hundred dollars, commencing January 1, 1952. Said salary shall be paid in equal monthly installments.

2. Pursuant to subdivision 5 of Section 305 of the county law, this law shall be subject to a permissive referendum and the clerk of the Board of Supervisors is hereby required to cause all necessary notices to be given pursuant to section 101 of the county law.

3. This law shall take effect immediately.
