A Local Law fixing the salaries of the following Hamilton County Officials for the balance of their respective terms of office.

Be it enacted by the Board of Supervisors of the County of Hamilton, State of New York, as follows:

SECTION 1. The Annual Salary of the following Hamilton County Officials is hereby fixed as follows until the end of their respective terms of office:

Hamilton County Treasurer .....	\$8,000.00
Hamilton County Clerk .....	\$8,500.00
Hamilton County Sheriff .....	\$5,200.00
Hamilton County Superintendent of Highways....	\$9,000.00

SECTION 2. This Local Law shall take effect FORTY-FIVE (45) DAYS after its adoption.
