WHEREAS, a Local Law No. 1 for 1969 of Hamilton County, New York which was "A Local Law to adopt Computerized Weighted-Voting Plan for Apportionment of the Board of Supervisors of the County of Hamilton", was filed and approved by the Board of Supervisors at a meeting held on February 6, 1969, and

WHEREAS, notices were duly published in the "Hamilton County News" and the "Leader-Herald" of Gloversville, New York giving notice that a Special Meeting and Public Hearing was to be held by the Board of Supervisors on February 25th, 1969, at the Supervisors' Chambers, at the Court House at Lake Pleasant, New York, and
