

LOCAL LAW NO. 1

COUNTY OF HAMILTON, NEW YORK 1972

Local Law No. 1 of the County of Hamilton, New York for 1972 amending sections 1-2 3-4 of Local Law No. 4 for 1970 to provide for the correction of the title of the position created by said law from "Director of Assessments of Hamilton County, New York" to "Director of Real Property Tax Services" and to provide that the appointment of the director shall be by "the majority affirmative vote of the total voting power of the Board."

BE IT ENACTED by the Board of Supervisors of the County of Hamilton as follows:

SECTION 1: Local Law No. 4 for 1970 of this County is hereby amended to read as follows:

"SECTION 1: There is hereby established a position of "Director of Real Property Tax Services", to be appointed by the Board of Supervisors of the County of Hamilton, New York, by the majority affirmative vote of the total voting power of the Board, and the duties of such Director shall be to prepare up-to-date tax maps, provide tax maps, provide appraisals of moderately complex property upon the request of Towns within Hamilton County when so required to do so.

SECTION 2: It shall be the duty of the said "Director of Real Property Tax Services" to coordinate assessments and procedures within the County of Hamilton and between all of the Towns of said County and to act in an advisory capacity to the Assessors duly appointed in the Towns of the County of Hamilton.

SECTION 3: The position of "Director of Real Property Tax Services" shall become effective January 1, 1971 for a term of six years at an annual salary of \$6,000.00, and that same be provided for by the Board of Supervisors in the 1971 budget.

SECTION 4: The "Director of Real Property Tax Services" shall be appointed by a Resolution of the Board of Supervisors, and the appointment shall take effect as of January 1, 1971.

SECTION 5: This Local Law shall take effect forty-five days after the adoption."

SECTION 2: This Local Law shall take effect twenty days after its adoption by the Board of Supervisors.
