**LOCAL LAW NO. 2
COUNTY OF HAMILTON, NEW YORK**

Local Law No. 2 of Hamilton County, New York for the year 1972 to provide authority to the Board of Supervisors to appoint a member of the Board to fill a vacant County office.

BE IT ENACTED by the Board of Supervisors of the County of Hamilton as follows:

SECTION 1: Whenever a vacancy occurs or exists in an appointive office, a person, otherwise qualified, who is a member of the Board of Supervisors at the time the vacancy occurs may be appointed to fill the vacancy provided he shall have resigned prior to such appointment.

SECTION 2: Such appointment shall be made by the majority affirmative vote of the total voting power of the Board of Supervisors.

SECTION 3: This Local Law shall take effect twenty days after its adoption.
