

LOCAL LAW NO. 3 OF 1972
COUNTY OF HAMILTON, NEW YORK

Local Law No. 3 of the County of Hamilton, New York for 1972 increasing the salary of the Hamilton County Judge for the period from April 1, 1972 to March 31, 1973 pursuant to Chapter 283 of the laws of the State of New York for 1972.

BE IT ENACTED by the Board of Supervisors of the County of Hamilton as follows:

SECTION 1: The salary of the Hamilton County Judge for the period from April 1, 1972 to March 31, 1973 is hereby fixed at Twenty Six Thousand Seventy Five and 00/100 Dollars (\$26,075.00) payable in equal monthly installments.

SECTION 2: That portion of the salary increase of One Thousand Seventy Five and 00/100 Dollars (\$1,075.00) earned between April 1, 1972 and the effective date of this law shall be paid in a lump sum at the next payroll period following the effective date of this law.

SECTION 3: This law shall take effect forty five (45) days after its adoption.
