LOCAL LAW NO. 1 FOR 1979

Hamilton County, New York

A LOCAL LAW FOR THE DIVISION OF HAMILTON
COUNTY INTO DISTRICTS AND THE ELECTION
OF CORONERS THEREIN

INTRODUCED BY MR. HOSLEY, JR.;
SECONDED BY MR. WADSWORTH;

BE IT ENACTED by the Board of Supervisors of the County of
Hamilton, State of New York, as follows:

SECTION 1. That Hamilton County for the purpose of electing
Coroners shall be divided into Three (3) districts as follows: District (1)
Towns of Indian Lake, Long Lake and Inlet; District (2) Towns of Lake
Pleasant, Arietta and Morehouse; District (3) Towns of Wells, Hope and
Benson.

SECTION 2. That one (1) Coroner shall be elected in each
district at the general election to be held in the year this local law
becomes effective.

SECTION 3. The Coroners elected in the 1979 general election
shall be for a term from and including January 1, 1980 to the date set
forth for the respective district: District (1) December 31, 1982;
District (2) December 31, 1981; District (3) December 31, 1980,
thereafter the term of office shall be three (3) years from and including
the first day of January next succeeding his election.

SECTION 4. The terms of office of all Coroners elected or
appointed and holding office in the County at the time this law becomes
effective shall expire on the December Thirty-first following.

SECTION 5. This local law is subject to a permissive referendum as provided in Subdivision 3 of Section 400 of County Law.

SECTION 6. This local law shall take effect forty-five (45) days after its adoption.
