LOCAL LAW NO. 1 OF THE YEAR 1985

COUNTY OF HAMILTON

A LOCAL LAW PROVIDING THAT THE COUNTY OF HAMILTON  
WILL NOT ENFORCE THE NEW YORK STATE  
UNIFORM FIRE PREVENTION AND BUILDING CODE.

Legislative Intent: The purpose of this Local Law is to provide that the County of Hamilton will not enforce the New York State Uniform Fire Prevention and Building Code.

BE IT ENACTED, by the Hamilton County Board of Supervisors as follows:

1. The Hamilton County Board of Supervisors hereby provides that the County of Hamilton will not enforce the New York State Uniform Fire Prevention and Building Code which became effective January 1st, 1984. This Local Law is adopted in accordance with the provisions of Section 381, paragraph 2, of the Executive Law of the State of New York.

2. The Clerk of this Board is hereby instructed to file a certified copy of this Local Law in the principal office of the State Fire Prevention and Building Code Counsel, Division of Housing and Community Renewal at Two World Trade Center, New York, New York 10047.

3. This Local Law shall take effect upon its being duly filed in the office of the Secretary of State.
