A local law FIXING THE ANNUAL SALARY OF THE HAMILTON COUNTY DISTRICT ATTORNEY.

Legislative Intent: The Hamilton County District Attorney's annual salary for the year 1987 was set by resolution at Eighteen Thousand Dollars (\$18,000.00) for the term of his office. That to bring the Hamilton County District Attorney's annual salary into conformity with the other elected officials', the annual salary for the Hamilton County District Attorney in the year 1987 will be Eighteen Thousand Nine Hundred Dollars (\$18,900.00); in the year 1988, Nineteen Thousand Eight Hundred Dollars (\$19,800.00); and in the year 1989, Twenty Thousand Seven Hundred Dollars (\$20,700.00).

BE IT ENACTED, by the Hamilton County Board of Supervisors as follows:

1. That the Hamilton County Board of Supervisors hereby fixes the Hamilton County District Attorney's annual salary for the year 1987 at Eighteen Thousand Nine Hundred Dollars (\$18,900.00), for the year 1988 at Nineteen Thousand Eight Hundred Dollars (\$19,800.00), and for the year 1989 at Twenty Thousand Seven Hundred Dollars (\$20,700.00).
2. Insofar as the provisions of this local law are inconsistent with the provisions of any other local law or act, the provisions of this local law shall be controlling.
3. This local law is subect to a referendum on petition and shall take effect forty-five (45) days after its adoption unless a petition protesting against such local law is filed with the Clerk and signed by qualified electors as required by law.
