Legislative Intent: The Hamilton County Treasurer's annual salary for the year 1989 was set by the Hamilton County Board of Supervisors at Twenty-Seven Thousand Eight Hundred Twenty-Five Dollars (\$27,825.00). That to bring the Hamilton County Treasurer's annual salary into conformity with the other appointed officials, the annual salary for the Hamilton County Treasurer for the year 1990 will be Twenty-Nine Thousand Two Hundred Dollars (\$29,200.00).

BE IT ENACTED, by the Hamilton County Board of Supervisors as follows:

1. That the Hamilton County Board of Supervisors hereby fixes the Hamilton County Tresurer's annual salary for the year 1990 at Twenty-Nine Thousand Two Hundred Dollars (\$29,200.00).

2. Insofar as the provisions of this local law are inconsistent with the provisions of other local laws or acts, the provisions of this local law shall be controlling.

3. This local law is subject to a referendum on petition and shall take effect forty-five days (45) after its adoption unless a petition protesting against such local law is filed with the Clerk and signed by qualified electors as required by law.
