Legislative Intent: The Hamilton County Republican and Democrat Commissioners of Election Annual Salaries for the year 1990 was set by the Hamilton County Board of Supervisors at Two Thousand Six Hundred Twenty - five Dollars ( \$2,625.00) for each Commissioner. That to bring the Hamilton County Republican and Democrat Election Commissioners' annual salaries into conformity with the other appointed officials, the annual salaries for the Hamilton County Republican and Democrat Commissioners of Election for the year 1991 will be Fifteen Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$15,500.00) for each Commissioner.

BE IT ENACTED, by the Hamilton County Board of Supervisors as follows:

1. That the Hamilton County Board of Supervisors hereby fixes the Hamilton County Republican and Democrat Election Commissioners' annual salaries for the year 1991. at Fifteen Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$15,500.00) per Commissioner.

2. Insofar as the provisions of this local law are inconsistent with the provisions of other local laws or acts, the provisions of this local law shall be controlling.

3. This local law is subject to a referendum on petition and shall take effect forty-five days (45) after its adoption unless a petition protesting against such local law is filed with the Clerk and signed by qualified electors as
