A local law fixing the annual salary of the Hamilton County Highway Superintendent

Legislative Intent: The Hamilton County Highway Superintendent's annual salary for the year 1996 was set by the Hamilton County Board of Supervisors at Thirty Seven Thousand Five Hundred Thirteen Dollars (\$37,513.00). That to bring the Hamilton County Highway Superintendent's annual salary into conformity with the other appointed officials, the annual salary for the Hamilton County Highway Superintendent for the year 1997 will be Thirty Eight Thousand Two Hundred Sixty Three Dollars (\$38,263.00).

BE IT ENACTED, by the Hamilton County Board of Supervisors as follows:

1. That the Hamilton County Board of Supervisors hereby fixes the Hamilton County Highway Superintendent's annual salary for the year 1997 at Thirty Eight Thousand Two Hundred Sixty Three Dollars (\$38,263.00).
2. Insofar as the provisions of this local law are inconsistent with the provisions of other local laws or acts, the provisions of this local law shall be controlling.
3. This local law is subject to a referendum on petition and shall take effect forty five (45) days after its adoption unless a petition protesting against such local law is filed with the Clerk and signed by qualified electors as required.
