Legislative Intent: The Hamilton County Treasurer's annual salary for the year 1998 was set by the Hamilton County Board of Supervisors at Thirty Seven Thousand Nine Hundred Ninety Five Dollars (\$37,995.00). That to bring the Hamilton County Treasurer's annual salary into conformity with the other appointed officials, the annual salary for the Hamilton County Treasurer for the year 1999 will be Thirty Eight Thousand Seven Hundred Fifty Five Dollars (\$38,755.00).

BE IT ENACTED, by the Hamilton County Board of Supervisors as follows:

1. That the Hamilton County Board of Supervisors hereby fixes the Hamilton County Treasurer's annual salary for the year 1999 at Thirty Eight Thousand Seven Hundred Fifty Five Dollars (\$38,755.00).
2. Insofar as the provisions of this local law are inconsistent with the provisions of other local laws or acts, the provisions of this local law shall be controlling.
3. This local law is subject to a referendum on petition and shall take effect forty five (45) days after its adoption unless a petition protesting against such local law is filed with the Clerk and signed by qualified electors as required.

5. (City local law concerning Charter revision proposed by petition.)
