Section I - Legislative Intent:

The Code of Ethics duly adopted by the Board of Supervisors in 1995 is unduly restrictive as to the advancement, promotion and placement for County employees and family members and is unduly restrictive with respect to contracts between the County and ex-County officers and employees and family members. The Board of Supervisors wishes to make employment advances, promotions and placements competitive and equal to all who apply, including County officers and employees and family members. In addition, the Board of Supervisors desires to permit ex-County officers and employees to contract with the County of Hamilton after a period of one (1) year.

Section II - Section 105.1.5 of the Hamilton County Code of Ethics is hereby repealed in its entirety.

Section III - A new Section 105.1.5 is hereby added to the Hamilton County Code of Ethics and shall read as follows:

"No ex-County officer or employee shall be entitled to have any business dealing, as defined by Section 104.4 of the Code of Ethics, with the County of Hamilton for a period of one (1) year from the date of separation of his or her employment with the County of Hamilton.

Nothing contained in this Code shall preclude a County officer, employee or a family member as defined by Section 104.8 of the Code of Ethics from applying for an employment position, or being considered for advancement or promotion or to fill a vacancy, providing that such officer, employee or family member is subject to the same selection process as a non-employee.

However, no such advancement, promotion or appointment to fill a vacancy shall violate any Federal or State statute or court decision. No County Supervisor shall participate in any decision for advancement, promotion or appointment to fill a vacancy wherein there would be a potential for a conflict of interest. Such County Supervisor shall immediately recuse himself or herself from all matters relating thereto. Such County Supervisor shall advise the Board of Supervisors of the potential conflict of interest.

Nothing herein contained shall prohibit the Board of Supervisors from adopting or amending a local law pursuant to Section 10 subdivision 1a(1) of the Municipal Home Rule Law. The Board of Supervisors shall have the power to adopt or amend a local law not inconsistent with the provisions of the Constitution or not inconsistent with any general law; relating to the powers, duties, qualifications, number, mode of selection and removal, terms of office, compensation, hours of work, protection, welfare and safety of its officers and employees, and shall include, but not be limited to, the creation or discontinuance of departments of its government and the prescription or modification of their powers and duties.”

Section IV - This Local Law shall take effect immediately upon its adoption and being filed in the Secretary of State’s Office of the State of New York.
