Legislative Intent: The Hamilton County Attorney and Social Services Attorney's annual salaries for the year 2000 were set by the Hamilton County Board of Supervisors at Twenty Six Thousand Eight Hundred Dollars (\$26,800.00). That to bring the Hamilton County Attorney and Social Services Attorney's annual salaries into conformity with the other appointed officials, the annual salaries for the Hamilton County Attorney and Social Services Attorney's for the year 2001 will be Twenty Nine Thousand Four Hundred Eighty Dollars (\$29,480.00).

BE IT ENACTED, by the Hamilton County Board of Supervisors as follows:

1. That the Hamilton County Board of Supervisors hereby fixes the Hamilton County Attorney and Social Services Attorney's annual salaries for the year 2001 at Twenty Nine Thousand Four Hundred Eighty Dollars (\$29,480.00).

2. Insofar as the provisions of this local law are inconsistent with the provisions of other local laws or acts, the provisions of this local law shall be controlling.

3. This local law is subject to a referendum on petition and shall take effect forty five (45) days after its adoption unless a petition protesting against such local law is filed with the Clerk and signed by qualified electors as required.
