Legislative Intent: The Hamilton County Clerk's annual salary for the year 2000 was set by the Hamilton County Board of Supervisors at Forty Two Thousand Two Hundred Ninety Seven Dollars (\$42,297.00). That to bring the Hamilton County Clerk's annual salary into conformity with the other appointed and elected officials, the annual salary for the Hamilton County Clerk for the year 2002 will be Forty Four Thousand Four Hundred Ninety Seven Dollars (\$44,497.00).

BE IT ENACTED, by the Hamilton County Board of Supervisors as follows:

1. That the Hamilton County Board of Supervisors hereby fixes the Hamilton County Clerk's annual salary for the year 2002 at Forty Four Thousand Four Hundred Ninety Seven Dollars (\$44,497.00).

2. Insofar as the provisions of this local law are inconsistent with the provisions of other local laws or acts, the provisions of this local law shall be controlling.

3. This local law is subject to a referendum on petition and shall take effect forty five (45) days after its adoption unless a petition protesting against such local law is filed with the Clerk and signed by qualified electors as required by law.
