A local law Authorizing the Establishment of a Board to be known as the

SECTION 1: This local law shall be entitled "Authorizing the Establishment of a Board to be known as The Industrial and Commercial Incentive Board."

SECTION 2: Legislative intent and purpose:

The Board of Supervisors of the County of Hamilton finds and determines that in order to help stimulate business in the County of Hamilton the establishment of an Industrial and Commercial Incentive Board could greatly benefit the County in that the Industrial and Commercial Incentive Board would present a plan to the County concerning the various types of business real property which should be granted eligibility for tax exemption with the opportunity for increased tax exemptions and to make recommendations to the County with respect to the actions it deems desirable to improve the economic climate which could greatly benefit the County in that new businesses would be encouraged to locate in the County, existing businesses would be encouraged to expand and new and expanded businesses would generate new jobs for Hamilton County Residents.

Section 3. The Industrial and Commercial Incentive Board is hereby created.

Section 4. Pursuant to Section 485-b (9) (d) of the New York State Real Property Tax Law the Industrial and Commercial Incentive Board shall consist of the following: three (3) representatives of the County: the appointment of one shall be reserved to the Chairman of the Board of Supervisors of the County who shall serve as chair, and one (1) each for the majority and the minority parties of the county legislative body; one (1) representative for each city located within the County upon recommendation of the mayor, at which time there are none, one (1) representative for each of the towns located within the County upon the recommendation of the supervisor; one (1) representative to collectively represent all of the villages with in the County, and one (1) representative to collectively represent all of the school boards association. The members shall serve at the pleasure of the governing body which they represent without salary but each such member may be reimbursed for their actual and necessary expenses incurred in performance of their duties upon prior approval by the Hamilton County Board of Supervisors.

Section 5. This local law shall take effect immediately upon its adoption and filing in the Office of the Secretary of State as provided by Section 27 of the Municipal Home Rule Law.
