1. Every instrument of document presented for recording in land records in the office of the Hamilton County Clerk, in order to entitle same to be recorded, shall have attached to the front of such document a Recording and Endorsement page. Endorsed on such page shall be a designation of each and every town or village in Hamilton County in which the land affected by such recording is situated.

The Recording and Endorsement page shall be recorded with the subject instrument preceded by the words "I hereby certify that the within and foregoing was recorded in the Clerk's Office of Hamilton County, New York."

2. The Hamilton County Clerk shall prepare an appropriate form for said Recording and Endorsement page in compliance with the requirements of this local law, and may require the use of said form or a facsimile thereof.

3. The Recording and Endorsement page shall form part of the land records and as such, shall be subject to the fees for filing certificates in the County Clerk's Office as specified in Section 8021 of New York Civil Practice Law and Rules.

This local law shall take effect January 1, 2006 in compliance with Sections 20, 21, and 27 of New York State Municipal Home Rule Law.
