

PROPOSED LOCAL LAW NO. 8 OF 2016

State of New York

**A LOCAL LAW RESCINDING LOCAL LAW NO. 12 OF 2015 A LOCAL LAW
OVERRIDING THE TAX LEVY LIMIT FOR HAMILTON COUNTY FOR 2016 THAT
WILL REQUIRE A TAX LEVY THAT IS GREATER THAN THE TAX LEVY LIMIT
FOR THE 2016 FISCAL YEAR**

BE IT ENCTED by the Board of Supervisors of the County of Hamilton as follows:

SECTION 1. TITLE

This Local Law Shall Be Known As “**A LOCAL LAW RESCINDING LOCAL LAW NO. 12 OF 2015 A LOCAL LAW OVERRIDING THE TAX LEVY LIMIT FOR HAMILTON COUNTY FOR 2016 THAT WILL REQUIRE A TAX LEVY THAT IS GREATER THAN THE TAX LEVY LIMIT FOR THE 2016 FISCAL YEAR**”

SECTION 2. LEGISLATIVE FINDS

The Board of Supervisors for the County of Hamilton herby finds and determines that the anticipated budgetary needs for fiscal year 2016 allowed Hamilton County to remain within the tax levy limit established by General Municipal Law §3-C, more commonly referred to as the “2% tax cap”, as that term is therein defined and calculated.

SECTION 3. ENACTMENT AUTHORITY

This Local Law is adopted pursuant to authority provided in section 10 of the Municipal Home Rule Law of the State of New York as well as the specific authority found in General Municipal Law §3-c[5].

SECTION 4. OVERRIDE AUTHORIZATION NOT REQUIRED

The Board of Supervisors has adopted a budget for fiscal year 2016 that does not exceed the “tax levy limit” as that term is defined and calculated pursuant to the provisions of General Municipal Law §3-c, and therefore, the Board of Supervisors authorize rescission of Local Law No. 12 of 2015.

SECTION 5. EFFECTIVE DATE

This local law shall take effect immediately upon filing with the Secretary of State.
