Federal Regulation Title 29: Labor. Part 553 – Application of the Fair Labor Standards Act to Employees of State and Local Governments

**AUTHORIZATION OF COMPENSATORY TIME OFF FOR HIGHWAY EMPLOYEES**

MOVED: Phillip Snyder

WHEREAS, the highway employees will be allowed to accumulate (per year) up to 30 hrs. of overtime which is 45 hrs. straight time

WHEREAS, those employees will be able to use as time off said hours at the discretion of the highway superintendent

WHEREAS, those employees must use any compensatory time saved after Jan. 1<sup>st</sup> of a given year, and must be used by Dec. 31<sup>st</sup> that same year, or lose said hours

WHEREAS, the highway superintendent will be responsible for keeping records and payroll sheets signed by himself and the employee and given to the supervisor

WHEREAS, the bookkeeper will track the compensatory time in the same manner as vacation or personal time

WHEREAS, this resolution will take effect February 23, 2014
