This is an entrance grade law enforcement position in the Sheriff's Department and includes responsibility for serving as a highway patrol officer, assisting in the investigation of criminal offenses and apprehension of criminals. Incumbents during a designated shift are also responsible for various functions within the department, including transport of prisoners, serving civil processes and court related services.

Minimum Qualifications: Graduation from high school or possession of a high school equivalency diploma as described in Section 58 of the Civil Service law and possession of a valid NYS driver's license at the time of appointment. Candidates must meet the physical and medical standard as prescribed by the NYS Municipal Police Training Council.

Proof of minimum qualifications are required at the time of application.

Special Requirements: Candidates must be at least 19 years of age on or before December 2, 2017 to be admitted to the written test. Eligibility for appointment begins when candidate reaches age 20. Candidates who reach their 35th birthday on or before the date of the written test are not qualified. However, time spent in the military, not exceeding six years, will be subtracted from the age of any applicant who has passed his thirty-fifth birthday.
