The incumbent has the responsibility for overseeing the efficient maintenance and operation of buildings, grounds and equipment. An employee in this class may supervise but generally performs work of a general mechanical nature, which may include masonry, carpentry, painting, plumbing, heating or electrical maintenance and repair as well as in grounds maintenance functions. Supervision is exercised over the work of cleaners. Incumbent does related work as required.

Minimum Qualifications:

- a) Graduation from a regionally accredited or NYS registered two (2) year college with an associate degree in construction or engineering technology and two (2) years of supervisory experience in buildings and grounds maintenance activities; OR
- b) Four (4) years of experience in buildings and grounds maintenance activities – two (2) years of which shall have been in a supervisory capacity; OR
- c) An equivalent combination of training and experience as outlined by the limits of a) & b) above.

Proof of minimum qualifications are required at the time of application.
