

## Hamilton County Board of Elections COVID-19 Guidance

### Voters:

- Signage will tell voters they must wear a mask; however, **we cannot deny the voter the right to vote if they refuse to wear a mask**. If the voter does not have a mask, there will be one provided. If they refuse, they will have to wait until any masked voter in line finishes voting. The unmasked voter will come in, vote, then leave. Workers will have to sanitize before letting anyone else in the poll site.
- Signage will tell voters to social distance from others maintaining six (6) feet even with their mask on.
- Signage will let them know that not more than ten (10) people (including workers) should be in the poll site at the same time.
- Hand sanitizer will be available to the voter to use in the poll site.
- While we don't want to rush voters, signage will tell them to kindly sign in, get their ballots (there will be 2) go to the voting booth, vote, cast their ballot and leave promptly.
- Signage will tell them there is no loitering after they cast their ballot.
