This position exists in the Police Department and is responsible for the protection of life and property within the department's jurisdiction through the enforcement of Vehicle and Traffic Law, New York State Criminal Procedure Law and local ordinances. This work involves responsibility for the enforcement of laws and ordinances and the protection of lives and property in an assigned area during a specific shift. The duties consist primarily of routine patrol tasks, assisting in investigation of criminal offenses and the apprehension of criminals. Direct supervision received from a higher-ranking officer.

**Minimum Qualifications:** Graduation from high school or possession of a high school equivalency diploma as described in Section 58 of the Civil Service law and possession of a valid NYS driver's license at the time of appointment. Candidates must meet the physical and medical standard as prescribed by the NYS Municipal Police Training Council.

**Special Requirements:** Candidates must be at least 19 years of age on or before September 26, 2020 to be admitted to the written test. Eligibility for appointment begins when candidate reaches age 20. Candidates who reach their 35<sup>th</sup> birthday on or before the date of the written test are not qualified. However, time spent in the military, not exceeding six years, will be subtracted from the age of any applicant who has passed his thirty-fifth birthday.

Candidates must be legal residents of Hamilton County or one of the contiguous counties of Essex, St. Lawrence, Franklin, Fulton, Herkimer, Saratoga, Warren or Washington for at least 30 days immediately preceding the date of the test.

**Proof of minimum qualifications are required at the time of application.**
