(5) Any other mark or writing outside the spaces provided for voting may void the entire ballot.
(6) The number of choices is listed for each contest. Do not mark the ballot for more candidates than allowed. If you do, your vote in that contest will not count.

(7) If you make a mistake, or want to change your vote, ask a poll worker for a new ballot.
(8) After completing your ballot, insert it into the ballot scanner and wait for the notice that your ballot has been successfully scanned. If no such notice appears, seek the assistance of an election inspector.
