Incumbents in this position identify, develop and implement service plans for needy children, adults and families, including victims of abuse/neglect and domestic violence, as well as recipients of public and medical assistance and all 21 services under the TITLE XX Program. Incumbents perform investigative activities, counseling and case management to all mandated and/or eligible clients. Rotational on-call to provide immediate response to child protective, adult protective and domestic violence crisis situations, 24 hours/day and 7 days/week, pursuant to New York State law.

You must be a resident of Hamilton, Essex, Franklin, Fulton, Herkimer, Saratoga, St. Lawrence, Warren or Washington Counties at least one month prior to examination date.

**Minimum Qualifications:**

- A) Graduation from a regionally accredited New York State registered college or university with a bachelor's degree or greater; OR
- B) Certified as a Registered Nurse with one (1) year of experience in that profession.

**Special Requirement:**

Must possess a valid New York State driver's license at time of appointment and demonstrate the ability to meet the transportation needs of the job.
