

2023 Early Voting – FAQ's

2023 Primary Election – June 27, 2023
2023 General Election – November 7, 2023

What is Early Voting?

Early voting is a nine (9) day period where voters can vote in-person before Election Day in their county.

Who can vote early?

All registered voters can vote early.

When can I vote early?

Early Voting in New York State will begin prior to the June 27th Primary Election. The early voting period will be from: **Saturday, June 17, 2023 through Sunday, June 25, 2023.**

Early Voting in New York State will begin prior to the November 7th General Election. The early voting period will be from: **Saturday, October 28, 2023 through Sunday, November 5, 2023.**

Where can I vote early?

How will I vote during early voting?

Voting during early voting is the same as voting on Election Day. When you get to the early voting center, you will check in to vote, receive your ballot and vote as any other election.

There will be instructions available at the early voting centers to familiarize you with the ballot. There will also be a notice to voter and bill of rights. You may ask an election inspector to explain how to vote, or if you need any assistance.

If you vote during the early voting period, you are not eligible to vote on Election Day.

When will early voting results be posted?

Early voting results will be canvassed and reported after 9pm on Tuesday, June 27, 2023 for the Primary Election and Tuesday, November 7, 2023 for the General Election.
