SECTION 1. As per Section 201 of County Law, the Board of Supervisors can only increase the salary of a county officer who is elected for a fixed term or appointed for a fixed term, in the middle of that term of office, if Section 24 (2)(h) of the Municipal Home Rule Law is complied with. In keeping with that compliance, Local Law No. 1 of 2025 is hereby enacted setting the annual salaries for the year 2025 for the following county officers who are elected or appointed for a fixed term, and whose terms did not expire on December 31, 2024.


