RESOLUTION OPPOSING EXECUTIVE ORDER 14238 OF 2025

DATED: AUGUST 7, 2025

WHEREAS, Executive Order 14238 states that seven agencies, including the Institute of Museum and Library Services (IMLS) be eliminated to the maximum extent of the law and further be it resolved that the agencies are ordered to reduce their services and personnel to the minimum amount required to perform the functions by law, and

WHEREAS, this Executive Order also orders the federal budget agency, The Office of Management and Budget (OMB) to reject any budget requests from IMLS (and the other six named agencies) other than funds needed to implement the closure of these agencies, and

WHEREAS, The New York State Library receives approximately \$8.1 million annually in Federal funding from the U.S. Institute of Museum and Library Services (IMLS). This funding supports the operations of the New York State Library and the seven thousand libraries, 72 Library systems across New York State, and

WHEREAS, The New York Public Library System consists of 23 Public Library Systems and the Southern Adirondack Library System which is made up of 34 public libraries in Hamilton, Saratoga, Warren and Washington Counties, and

WHEREAS, Libraries serve their communities year-round to provide its patrons with cultural enrichment through materials and programming, access to information and technology, and the tools for lifelong learning and to foster a love of reading, and

WHEREAS, Libraries build relationships with other community partners to bring information and entertainment to the community in a safe, friendly venue that is open to all, and

WHEREAS, Libraries serve from their youngest to their oldest visitor and patron to provide the best experiences possible so there are no barriers to the joy of lifelong learning, be it

RESOLVED, the Hamilton County Board of Supervisors implores that funding be restored to The Institute of Museum and Library Services to continue the services needed by our constituents of Hamilton County.
