

IDA Awards 12 Grants

More than \$144,000 in NYS Office of Community Renewal Microenterprise Grants were awarded to 12 Hamilton County businesses, some established, some brand new. All awards are contingent upon the completion by of 8 entrepreneurial training sessions and submission of additional project information. Some \$19,000 in Microenterprise Grant funds remain, but a second round of funding will not be announced for at least six months, the IDA decided.

“Microenterprise Funds are available only every five to six years,” according to IDA Executive Director Ann Melious. “Grants to small businesses are few and far between, but we continue to offer low interest loans.”
